

Getting hitched at a hotel chapel doesn't always mean a trip to Vegas. We break down the best places around the world, where you can go from ceremony to cocktail hour in a matter of minutes.

LOS CABOS, MEXICO

ONE&ONLY PALMILLA

STEAL AWAY TO CABO FOR A BEACH WEDDING ON the Baja Peninsula, beloved vacation spot of such Hollywood legends as John Wayne and Lucille Ball.

THE CEREMONY: Reserve six to eight months in advance; the chapel can accommodate 40 guests inside and 150 more outside. **THE RECEPTION:** Venues include the resort's outdoor pool deck (up to 250 guests) and the ballroom, with stage (150).

THE DOWNTIME: Snorkeling in the Sea of Cortez. *palmilla.one-andonlyresorts.com*

THE ACCOMMODATIONS: A one-bedroom suite is the most popular option for the bride to be, as there's ample space to get ready. Guests can stay in the remaining 172 rooms.

THE FINE PRINT: The hotel provides all food and beverages, and must sign off on outside vendors, such as photographers and DJs. You'll also need to make your own arrangements (such as a trip to City Hall) to ensure that the marriage is legal in the U.S.

THE PERKS: Your very own horse-drawn carriage and footman,

THE CEREMONY: Book the popular Cloister Chapel, which seats 75 people, up to a year in advance.

THE RECEPTION: Typically held in the hotel ballroom, which can fit 400 guests.

THE ACCOMMODATIONS:


The wedding package includes a complimentary room for a night—with rose petals and champagne—for the bride and groom.

THE FINE PRINT: Thanks to an event design team, everything from table linens to floral arrangements will be taken care of on-site.

THE PERKS: Access to Sea Island's famous yacht club,

spa, and beach club.



INSIDER TIP > Have a casual

rehearsal dinner on nearby Rainbow Island, which is equipped with picnic

tables and an oyster roasting station.

TE CDY WINTER WHITES A couple get married in a snow-covered chapel in Colorado's San Juan Mountains. FUN FACT > During summer, some bridal parties pick flowers in the meadows instead of hiring a florist.

COLORADO

DUNTON HOT SPRINGS

THIS BARE-BONES SPA RESORT, A former ghost town near Telluride, is a great venue for a rustic gathering.

THE CEREMONY: Up to 60 guests can be seated on the outdoor benches and chairs. Pendleton blankets are supplied if the weather gets chilly.

THE RECEPTION: Typically held in town at the hotel-owned Saloon and Dance Hall.


THE ACCOMMODATIONS: Stay at the

Well House, the only cabin with a private hot springs soaking tub.


THE FINE PRINT: Dunton Hot Springs has no vendor restrictions. Brides have booked two years in advance for a buyout, which allows 44 guests to stay overnight.

THE PERKS: Colorado lets just about anyone marry you with the right license.

THE DOWNTIME: A restorative dip in the springs, of course. *duntonhotsprings.com*







CALIFORNIA

MISSION INN HOTEL & SPA

A WEDDING AT MISSION Inn, with its stained glass windows and stunning architecture, truly feels like a fairy tale. THE CEREMONY: There's room for 150 in the historic St. Francis of Assisi chapel, an hour outside Los Angeles. THE RECEPTION: Options include the Music Room, which resembles the banquet hall of a castle, and the art gallery. THE ACCOMMODATIONS: Stay in the Alhambra Suite, where Ron and Nancy Reagan started their honeymoon. THE FINE PRINT: You have to pick vendors from Mission's exclusive list. THE PERKS: The Tuscan-inspired spa, which has a eucalyptus steam room, is great for bridal party pampering. THE DOWNTIME: Take a guided tour of the hotel's museum and two chapels. missioninn.com

URUGUAY

ESTANCIA VIK

THIS SPANISH COLONIAL-STYLE resort draws art and food lovers alike. THE CEREMONY: The open-air chapel holds up to 150 guests. THE RECEPTION: Put up a tent almost anywhere on the 4,000-acre property. THE ACCOMMODATIONS: Stay in a master suite (designed by local artists); each has a fireplace and a balcony. THE FINE PRINT: A buyout of the 12-suite resort is required. No vendor restrictions, but you'll have to ensure that the marriage is legal at home. THE PERKS: A complimentary threenight stay on your first anniversary. THE DOWNTIME: Head to beachside sister property Playa Vik for a swim. vikretreats.com





THE INN AT PALMETTO BLUFF

EMBRACE SOUTHERN HOSPITALITY by celebrating in the Lowcountry.

THE CEREMONY: The charming Waterside Chapel holds 90 guests. Book a year in advance.

THE RECEPTION: Typically at the inn's River House Ballroom, which seats 200. The veranda has views of the May River.

THE ACCOMMODATIONS: Fifty cozy guest cottages, including eight suites.

THE FINE PRINT: Food and beverages come from the resort. To legally marry, you'll need a South Carolina license, which takes 24 hours to process.

THE PERKS: Have your rehearsal dinner in the 4,000-bottle wine cellar.

THE DOWNTIME: Canoe or kayak along the river to explore freshwater trails, or take a day trip to Savannah. *palmetto-bluffresort.com*
