Biking

One of the best ways to see Sea Island, bike rentals are available throughout the resort on a first-come, first-served basis. With miles and miles of smooth, flat, bike-friendly paths, it's easy to sit back and explore Sea Island on your own. Or join a naturalist for a 'Coastal Wildlife Bike Tour' to learn more about the surrounding environment.

Boating/Fishing

Sea Island Explorer, a state-of-the-art, three-level vessel provides guests the ability to book scenic cruises. Private and group tours of the salt marsh are available. The waterways that surround Sea Island offer the opportunity for some of the best year-round fishing trips on the East Coast - book one of several varied fishing trips for the opportunity to reel in a catch (and even have a chef prepare it for your dinner).

Falconry

Take a Hawk Walk on Rainbow Island with a falconer and bird of prey. Witness the high-flying action firsthand and enjoy the thrill of having a raptor fly to your gloved fist. Or book the Owl Prowl to meet some of the resort's resident birds and dissect an owl pellet.

Hunting/Shooting

Learn the art of clay target shooting at one of the nation's best facilities and one of the country's first skeet clubs. Additional Shooting School offerings include archery, air rifles, and individual/group shooting lessons. Or visit us at Broadfield, Sea Island's 5,800-acre Sporting Club and Lodge. At one of the South's earliest hunting clubs, guests can enjoy the rifle and pistol range, 12-station sporting clays course, or quail/pheasant hunting excursions.

Horseback Riding

Saddle up for a horseback ride through miles of maritime forests or beach dunes. Explore the coastal habitat of Georgia's beaches. For experienced equestrians, Equestrian Instruction Lessons are available in hunter, jumper, equitation, saddleseat, dressage, and western disciplines.

Nature Center

Located within Sea Island Beach Club, the Sea Island Nature Center celebrates Golden Isles wildlife and ecosystems. Learn about coastal ecology from our team of resident naturalists and view exhibits featuring reptiles and marine life. The Sea Island Nature Center is an immersive experience for kids and adults alike.

Nature Tours

A variety of eco-tour offerings include the Marsh Habitat and Wildlife Walk, Birding Tour, and the Sea Island Junior Naturalist program for budding nature enthusiasts.

Sea Turtle Program

From mid-May to early October, explore the Sea Island beach at sunrise with the nature team as they patrol for nesting and hatching sea turtles. Or take a nighttime stroll with our nature team as they search for nesting females and hatchlings. And if you want to be involved even after you leave Sea Island, adopt a sea turtle nest through the resort's Adopt-a-Nest program

With vast riverways and expansive ocean waters to be explored, guests can book activities like stand-up paddleboarding marsh tours, kayak trips, Hobie Cat® sailing lessons and tours, kiteboarding, and more, with something for all levels of expertise.
