SEA ISLAND PROPERTY OVERVIEW

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Setting

Located on the southeastern coast of Georgia, Sea Island features five miles of private beach, a Beach Club, tennis center, Yacht Club, Shooting School, and children's programs, as well as three championship golf courses, including Seaside and Plantation, home of the PGA TOUR's RSM Classic. Located on St. Simons Island, The Inn at Sea Island offers casual accommodations with access to many Sea Island amenities. Broadfield, a Sea Island Sporting Club and Lodge, offers seasonal hunting and fishing opportunities.

Transportation

Sea Island, located off the southeastern coast of Georgia, is situated halfway between Savannah, GA and Jacksonville, FL. The resort is easily accessible from three public airports: 60-minute drive from Jacksonville International Airport (JAX), 75-minute drive from Savannah International Airport (SAV), and 20 minutes from the Brunswick Golden Isles Airport (BQK). McKinnon St. Simons Island Airport is a private airport located 10 minutes from The Cloister and 5 minutes from The Lodge. Sea Island transportation is readily available from all airports.

Architecture

The Cloister at Sea Island is a Mediterranean-style structure that was designed by renowned Palm Beach architect Addison Mizner in 1928. The original building welcomed guests from around the world for 75 years, until 2003 when the new, Mizner-inspired structure was designed by architects Peter Capone and Michael Ramsey and built to honor, yet update, the original structure. Located at the end of St. Simons Island's historic Avenue of Oaks, The Lodge at Sea Island is the premiere hideaway reminiscent of an English country manor. Mizner's design also influenced The Inn at Sea Island, located two miles from Sea Island and four miles from The Lodge and Sea Island.

Accommodations

Golf course, seashore. River view, salt marshes. Surrounded by activity, away from it all. English-style manor, Mediterranean elegance. Sporting grounds, beach club. For guests of Sea Island, there are many beautiful accommodations choices from which to choose.

The Cloister at Sea Island

The Forbes Five-Star Cloister is a Mediterranean masterpiece that preserves the original architecture's illustrious history and unique essence. Set on 50 lush acres, The Cloister's 265 elegant guest rooms and suites offer sweeping views of the Black Banks River, Atlantic Ocean, and natural setting. Cloister accommodations include rooms and suites in the Main Building and adjacent wings, suites in the Sea Island Beach Club, and 1-, 2- and 3-bedroom accommodations in The Cloister Ocean Residences. Uniquely designed rooms are defined by elegance, sophistication, and comfort featuring gleaming wood furnishings, exposed beam ceilings, stone baths with deep-soaking tubs, overstuffed chairs, hardwood floors, and handmade Turkish rugs. From a bird's-eye view, The Cloister encompasses a sprawling range of world-class buildings and amenities, including the Sea Island Yacht Club, The Spa at Sea Island, and the Sea Island Beach Club, which includes Sea Island Kids, a gathering point for Camp Cloister and children's activities.

The Lodge at Sea Island

The AAA Five-Diamond, Forbes Five-Star Lodge caters to guests seeking ultimate privacy and luxury. The intimate 58-room hotel and golf clubhouse offers expansive ocean views and is surrounded by the emerald fairways of the Sea Island Golf Club. The Lodge is the heart of Sea Island's legendary golf mecca, with two championship golf courses within arm's reach. The stunning accommodations offer the feel of a classic English country manor with rich wood, exposed beams, spacious marble baths with deep-soaking tubs and rainfall showers. The Lodge also includes seven cottages with eighteen sleeping rooms total, oceanfront pool and pool house, and an 18-hole putting course called Speedway. Personalized for golfers, the Sea Island Golf Performance Center features industry-leading technology, six instruction and club fitting bays, a putting studio, and more. The Lodge features first-class amenities including 24-hour butler service, freshly baked cookies, and a daily performance by the resort's resident bagpiper at sundown.

The Inn at Sea Island

Located on St. Simons Island, two miles from The Cloister on Sea Island and four miles from the Sea Island Golf Club, historic sites and shopping on St. Simons Island, The Inn at Sea Island reflects the signature Addison Mizner Mediterranean design seen throughout Sea Island. With 85 guest rooms, The Inn at Sea Island offers casual, comfortable accommodations, continental breakfast, evening bar, Topgolf Swing Suite, heated pool, workout room, complimentary laundry facilities, and transportation to Sea Island and the Sea Island Golf Club. The Inn guests may access select Sea Island amenities and activities such as golf, spa, dining, and tennis, for an additional fee during specific times of the year.

Sea Island Cottage Rentals

Renting a cottage on Sea Island is a tradition for many resort guests. Of approximately 600 privately owned cottages on Sea Island, 140 are available for rent. Each is uniquely designed, providing guests with a selection of styles and décor from which to choose. The homes range from three to eight bedrooms and most residences offer beach, salt marsh, or tidal creek views. Cottage rentals include access to dining, golf, spa, and access to The Cloister, The Lodge, and Sea Island Beach Club.

Broadfield, A Sea Island Sporting Club

Carved from one of the South's earliest hunting clubs is Broadfield, Sea Island's 5,800-acre Sporting Club and Lodge. Surrounded by expansive live oaks, fanning palmettos, and towering pines. And quail, pheasant, and lakes full of largemouth bass. The landscape is secluded, but you have everything you need—comfortable accommodations, modern amenities, traditional farmhouse kitchen, welcoming open porches, country library with fireplace, beautiful dining room.

Dining

Sea Island's gracious hospitality extends from its unparalleled accommodations and engaging activities to a remarkable range of dining options, from refined cuisine to beachfront munchies. Each restaurant offers a unique take, under the expert direction of Jonathan Jerusalem, Resort Director of Food and Beverage.

Tavola *(The Cloister at Sea Island)*

An authentic, rustic Italian eatery with a river view, Tavola showcases a warm ambiance that invites guests to interact with the chef who tosses pizza, slices house-cured prosciutto, and bakes mouthwatering olive ciabatta in the restaurant's brick pizza oven.

River Bar & Lounge *(The Cloister at Sea Island)*

The simple elegance of its wood-topped tables and bar combined with beers on tap, an extensive wine list, single malt scotch, and a fine selection of bourbon and whiskey make the River Bar a favorite gathering place. The menu features casual and creative cuisine with a French and European twist, perfect for sharing around the table as guests take in panoramic views of the Black Banks River.

Colt & Alison *(The Lodge at Sea Island)*

High-back leather chairs invite relaxation while guests enjoy golf course views and the glow of a wood-burning fireplace. Colt & Alison patrons savor masterfully prepared USDA Prime wet- and dry-aged beef and fresh seafood, paired with an extensive selection of wines by our sommeliers.

Oak Room *(The Lodge at Sea Island)*

This oak-lined venue's ambiance comes from hand-painted murals, leather ceilings, wood-burning fireplace, outdoor terrace with sprawling views, and sounds of the nearby bagpiper. The tavern menu ranges from local fried shrimp to a classic Cobb salad and award-winning Shrimp and Grits.

Men's Locker Room *(The Lodge at Sea Island)*

This 6,000-square-foot haven is considered by many PGA touring pros to be "the greatest locker room in golf." Equipped with a full bar, cigar room, and daily lunch service.

Pool and Halfway House *(The Lodge at Sea Island)*

Overlooking the St. Simons Sound and Atlantic Ocean, this spot serves breakfast, lunch, and cocktails until dusk.

Southern Tide *(Sea Island Beach Club)*

Snack Shack *(Sea Island Beach Club)*

Located in the heart of Sea Island Beach Club, Snack Shack's varied menu features casual fare such as amazing burgers, hot dogs, sandwiches, and chilled salads. Snack Shack appeals to beach and pool guests with seating on the terrace, overlooking the family pool.

Sea Strike & Pub *(Sea Island Beach Club)*

Far from the ordinary, this experience features favorite fares, draft beer, and cocktails on a creative gastropub menu. Guests are invited to grab a table, sit at the bar, or challenge friends to a game of 10-pin bowling.

In-Room Dining *(The Cloister at Sea Island, The Lodge at Sea Island, Sea Island Cottage Rentals)*

Guests can order from a menu of Southern staples, family favorites, and even pet offerings. These fresh and healthy options include longstanding favorites and inventive culinary creations, often based on the travels and epicurean journeys of Sea Island's culinary team. Available 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.

Wine Cellars *(The Cloister at Sea Island and The Lodge at Sea Island)*

Guests can step back in time through exposed-brick staircases by candlelight to the intimate, bottle-lined chambers to a very private multi-course meal at The Cloister and The Lodge. In The Cloister Wine Cellar patrons can dine on a handmade English oak estate table adjacent to ironwork imported from England and France and sip from Sea Island's impressive award-winning wine collection—more than 1,000 labels of old and new world vintages. The Lodge Wine Cellar, guests can dine on featured selections from Colt & Alison's menu paired with the resort's impressive award-winning wine collection. The collection offers prestigious international classics, traditional favorites, and adventurous varietals, as well as five exclusive Sea Island private-label wines produced by esteemed vintners. Both cellars are perfect for small, intimate gatherings, and must be booked in their entirety.

Golf

The Sea Island Golf Performance Center is one of the resort's signature experiences. The state-of-the-art facility offers six hitting and instruction bays, Zen Greenstage Putting Lab, 300 yards of teeing area, target greens, short-game areas, and an exclusive club-fitting service. The Sea Island Golf Performance Center has a holistic, multidisciplinary approach to the game and a team of exemplary instructors who welcome all different levels of players, including some of the top PGA professionals. Sea Island Golf Club's 18-hole championship courses are situated on a few of the country's most breathtaking landscapes.

Seaside Course

Par 70; Six tee areas; 5,048 to 7,005 yards; 120 to 141 slope

Situated at the southern tip of St. Simons Island, Seaside is the pinnacle of links golf. A true links-style course – linking the sea to the land – features 15 holes flanked by captivating views of the Georgia coast's diverse landscapes. Sweeping dunes mix with the native grasses and wildflowers. Offering Sea Island's most demanding layout, Seaside is the host venue for the PGA TOUR's RSM Classic, as is Plantation Course.

Plantation Course

Par 72; eight tee areas; 4,129 to 7,093 yards; 106 to 130 slope

Sea Island's original course, designed in 1928 by Walter Travis, Plantation was updated in 1998 by Rees Jones and re-opened following a complete renovation in 2019 by Davis Love III and his brother, Mark. With a nod to classic architecture, Love Golf Design used influences from golf architecture legends Walter Travis, Donald Ross, C.B McDonald, and Seth Raynor to create the new Plantation masterpiece. With strategic bunkering and classic green complexes, Plantation plays through majestic oaks and along the water. Views throughout are long and breathtaking, while a premium is placed on accurate shots to the green. A great mix of short and long holes gives the player a fun and visual challenge, with green complexes that offer a fun challenge on each hole.

Retreat Course

Par 72; Six tee areas; 5,194 to 7,000 yards, 122 to 136 slope

When Davis Love III and his brother, Mark, began renovating the Retreat Course in October 2000, they knew they had a difficult task. Blending the players' preferences from the previous design, the brothers created a uniquely dramatic design. The green complexes are a combination of slope, sand bunkers, and undulations creating a masterful test challenging the golfer to hit a variety of shots.

The Spa at Sea Island

Inspired by water, the Forbes Five-Star Spa at Sea Island is a 65,000-square-foot haven for guests and members seeking a sanctuary of unparalleled elegance and serenity. The expert staff of therapists, consultants, and providers at The Spa at Sea Island offers a wide array of massages, body, and skin care treatments. Anchored by its warm and inviting spaces, guests and members may enjoy highlights such as the Water Rotunda featuring a hydrotherapy pool and cascading waterfall, eucalyptus-infused steam room, and Somadome Therapy Pod. A strength and cardio studio features over 5,000 square feet of training equipment and over 56 group fitness classes that are held each week in four studios dedicated to personal training, yoga, and Pilates. The fitness center also features an indoor lap pool and outdoor courtyards.

Experiences

At Sea Island, we have endless outdoor/indoor activities for guests and members to enjoy. Alternate days between relaxation and rejuvenation or adventure and exploration.

Boating

The marsh surrounding Sea Island makes a beautiful and unforgettable setting. On Sea Island's boats, including a 71-foot custom yacht, the *Sea Island Explorer*, guests observe captivating landscapes and unique ecosystems up close and personal - spending a casual afternoon gliding along Georgia's coastal waters and salt marshes, spotting playful dolphins along the way. Bookable activities include a scenic yacht cruise, pre-dinner cruises, and nature and history tours.

Bowling

Located inside Sea Strike & Pub, within Sea Island Beach Club, are six bowling lanes available for hourly play for up to six people per lane. Forget everything you think you know about bowling alleys and welcome to ours. Beautiful bar, tall ceilings, gorgeous wood. Naturally, bowling is the name of the game at Sea Strike & Pub, but guests may also enjoy shuffleboard, darts, and a giant magnetic Scrabble board mounted on the wall. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a participating adult or guardian at all times.

Falconry

Guests can join the Sea Island nature and falconry teams for exciting, hands-on experiences as they explore the 4,000-year-old tradition of falconry. Take a Hawk Walk on Rainbow Island with a falconer and bird of prey. Witness the high-flying action firsthand and enjoy the thrill of having a raptor fly to your gloved fist. Or book the Owl Prowl to meet some of the resort's resident birds and dissect an owl pellet. Or experience Broadfield, A Sea Island Sporting Club, for a half-day outing watching a falcon capable of speeds around 200 miles per hour, in hot pursuit of game birds.

Fishing

The waterways that surround Sea Island offer the opportunity for some of the best year-round fishing trips on the east coast. Thanks to the resort's fleet of customized fishing boats, guests can fish anywhere from shallow water creeks to 80 miles offshore in the Gulf Stream. Surrounding artificial and natural reef structures offer nonstop action throughout the year. Sea Island's full-time guides are on the water more than 300 days a year, focused on catching fish and customizing visitor experiences. Whether families want to introduce their children to fishing for the first time or experienced fishers want to show off their skills, Sea Island has the perfect excursion available.

Horseback

Sea Island is one of the very few resorts that offers horseback rides on the shore, along the dunes, or through marshes. This not-to-be-missed Sea Island experience is a unique way to explore the ocean beach habitat of the Georgia coast. Riders ages 10 years and older are invited to participate in this invigorating activity. Additional tailored experiences are offered to both skilled and novice riders.

Nature

Sea Island maintains a high level of responsibility as a steward of the coastal habitat and its natural beauty. Through the Sea Island Nature Center, the resort offers a variety of unique explorations through tidal salt marsh, ocean beach and dune habitats. In addition to activities such as turtle explorations, birding, horseback riding, boating, shelling, sailing, fishing, and kayaking, Sea Island offers enhanced, curated programs that are designed to educate guests, as well as encourage exploration and interest in nature and ecology. The Sea Island Junior Naturalist programs teach through hands-on experiences as kids learn about the ecosystems and wildlife on Sea Island. Sea Turtle Education and Night Walks and Dawn Patrols take guests along the beach to search for sea turtle tracks, nests, and hatchlings.

Pickleball

At Sea Island, the Retreat Tennis Center has eight pickleball courts, currently used for group clinics, private lessons, and open play. Mostly aimed at adults, private pickleball lessons for children can be arranged as well.

Sea Island Beach Club

Overlooking five miles of private beach on the Atlantic Ocean, the Sea Island Beach Club offers guests an endless supply of engaging activities including: three heated pools, water slide, bowling alley and pub, playground, volleyball court, kayaking, sailing, surfcasting, and summertime kiteboarding.

Shooting

The Sea Island Shooting School provides guests an opportunity to participate in the time-honored sport of shooting. This classic sport is preserved and pursued at one of the premier shooting facilities in the U.S. Novices are invited to take part in private or group lessons with NCSA-certified instructors while experienced shooters can participate in skeet, trap, and five-stand practice sessions.

Speedway Putting Course

Located at The Lodge at Sea Island, The Speedway Putting Course is an 18-hole putting course, designed by Mark Love and Davis Love III. This is the perfect activity for guest and members to enjoy year-round. Open Wednesday-Monday, 10 a.m.-10 p.m. and Tuesday, 1-10 p.m. Beverages are available each evening. Reservations not taken.

Squash

Squash courts at Sea Island include two international single courts and one North American handball doubles court. Sea Island is one of few domestic resorts to offer a squash program.

Tennis

Tennis at Sea Island serves up creative programming with year-round instruction for adults and children, as well as clinics, round robins, and partner matching. The resort offers 16 Har-Tru® courts, including 8 lighted courts, and fast-dry clay composition courts, including one stadium court.

Topgolf Swing Suite

The Topgolf Swing Suite, located at the Inn at Sea Island, features two simulator bays for up to eight players, offering interactive gaming beyond golf, including Topgolf target games, Baseball Pitching, Hockey Shots, Quarterback Challenge, Zombie Dodgeball, and Carnival Games. The Swing Suite's setting includes food and beverage service and TV viewing. Those choosing to swing a golf club can opt to play 84 real-life golf courses, including Seaside Course at the Sea Island Golf Club. Open daily from 5 – 10 p.m., the Topgolf Swing Suite accommodates up to eight players per bay. Daily play is available on a first-come, first-served basis. With reservations, it is also available for birthday parties and other private events and social gatherings.

Broadfield, A Sea Island Sporting Club and Lodge

Carved from one of the South's earliest hunting clubs is Broadfield, Sea Island's 5,800-acre Sporting Club and Lodge. Surrounded by expansive live oaks, fanning palmettos, towering pines, quail, pheasant, and lakes full of largemouth bass, guests enjoy comfortable accommodations, modern amenities, a traditional farmhouse kitchen, welcoming open porches, a country library with fireplace, and a beautiful dining room. The compound—a stunning Lodge and Guest House, with a combined maximum sleeping occupancy of 18 guests—may be rented in its entirety by one group or by two separate groups. The Pool House offers additional lodging for groups renting the entire compound. The property offers a wide array of activities including a rifle and pistol range, freshwater fishing, extensive hunting grounds, and a multitude of game including quail, deer, wild turkeys, and doves. Guests can choose to enjoy southern-style meals prepared by the Broadfield chef, complete with honey from one of the on-site beehives and smoked fresh meat and fish.

Children

Sea Island's Junior Staff devotes full attention to imaginative and engaging programs that children of all ages find enchanting. Popular activities include Camp Cloister, Cookie Cutters, Under-the-Sea Workshops and Bingo. Teenagers are encouraged to mix and mingle during sports tournaments, movies, kayaking tours, golf, and tennis lessons. Cooking classes, nature hikes, and many other events at Sea Island are designed to foster family participation. Customized itineraries are available.

Conferences

The Cloister at Sea Island offers world class, high-tech meeting space, which overlooks the Georgia coastline, features more than 42,000 sq. ft. of indoor function space, including the elegant 7,800-square-foot ballroom accommodating up to 600 attendees and the 5,000 sq. ft. Mizner Ballroom, opened in 2015. The Cloister was the site of the 2004 G8 Summit, with leaders of the world's major industrial powers. Sea Island is the only resort in the U.S. to host at G8 Summit. Two superb restaurants and three meeting rooms set the stage for a highly productive meeting at The Lodge at Sea Island.

Traditions at Sea Island

We invite you to time travel with us through some of Sea Island's most beloved traditions that have evolved over our 93-year history. We hope this journey will bring fond reminiscences of time well spent and put a smile on your face as you look forward to being part of these traditions when we can again welcome you home to Sea Island.

4th of July

No place celebrates the Fourth of July quite like Sea Island. There is an energy and excitement about the holiday that is hard to resist. Waving American flags lining Sea Island Drive usher in the Fourth and inspire a patriotic and celebratory mood in everyone. A day full of festive activities including some unique ones (most likely only found at Sea Island) culminate in a fitting tribute to America's independence, a fireworks spectacular that illuminates the night sky with the best seat in the house being our five miles of private beach.

Bagpipers

A figure steps onto the fairway of The Speedway course. The silhouette – the A-line of a kilt and Great Highland bagpipes – cuts a classic figure against the setting sun. As the piper begins to play, the plaintive notes reverberate across the course and drift out to the sea, signaling the close of another day of golf at Sea Island. Children, fascinated by the bagpipes and the piper's traditional attire, often trail the piper, working up the courage to approach him with questions. Once the sky is dark, the piper disappears from sight, leaving only the lilting sounds of Scotland floating in the air.

Bingo

Throughout the summer and during special times of year, gentlemen don jackets, ladies dress in their finest and children wear their “Sunday best,” while playing the famous game with the hopes of winning cash prizes. Legendary callers shout familiar phrases coined by Sea Island guests such as “ClicketyClick, O-66,” and “Par for the Course, O-72.”

Christmas

Christmas is particularly festive at Sea Island, full of twinkling Christmas trees, a life-sized gingerbread house, and angelic carolers. At the annual “Elf Tuck-In,” Santa’s Junior Staff “elves” put children to sleep with a warm cookie, milk and bedtime Christmas story. The “Reindog Parade” displays costumed pets and awards the one designated as most likely to lead Santa’s sleigh. At the Children’s Christmas Eve Party, Santa and Mrs. Claus arrive with fanfare and a present for every child, creating memories to last a lifetime.

Corn Muffins and Gold Brick Sundaes

Dining has long been celebrated at Sea Island. From buttery corn muffins and Gold Brick Sundaes to local shrimp and fresh fruit cobbler, many of the resort’s popular dishes were created years ago and continue to be requested by hundreds of guests who come back to Sea Island year after year.

Easter

The Sea Island annual Easter Egg Hunt began more than 40 years ago and today sends children on the joyful mission of finding more than 10,000 eggs hidden throughout the grounds. The Easter Bunny visits the crowd and leads the annual “Bunny Hop Fun Run” down the beach. A non-denominational Sunrise Service is held on Sea Island Beach on Easter morning.

New Year’s Celebrations

From the spectacular annual display of fireworks launched from Sea Island Beach on New Year’s Eve to the morning-after reviving Polar Bear Plunge in the Atlantic Ocean, Sea Island celebrates New Year’s with festivity.

Rainbow Island Suppers

A spread of local seafood under the stars and accompanying sounds of nature during a break in the music signal that this week’s tradition is a Rainbow Island Supper, which began more than a half-century ago. While the location changed from the north end of the island to Rainbow Island, the menu has remained almost the same. Tried and true Southern favorites include hush puppies, oysters, shrimp, and coleslaw with a few healthier options added over the years.

Thanksgiving

Thanksgiving is a fêted time of joy at Sea Island, as guests come year after year to break bread with their families. During Sea Island’s annual “Turkey Trot Fun Run,” guests follow the turkey down the beach and have no qualms about enjoying a Thanksgiving feast later that afternoon.

Welcoming Dignitaries

Throughout our 93-year history, dignitaries have chosen Sea Island for the same reasons that other guests have – our blend of gracious Southern hospitality combined with an incredibly beautiful, private natural setting.
